## **Rules of Behaviors**

ISK Our world is a nice & healthy environment for everyone therefore....

- We put our coat & phone in our locker.
- We do not wear a cap, hat or hood, religious head coverings are allowed.
- We do not chew gum.
- We do not smoke or vape.
- We do not use alcohol or drugs and we do not drink energy drinks.
- We are not allowed to use weapons such as knives.

#### Social media

- 1. Only the management makes official announcements about the school.
- 2. You must not take unsolicited photos or videos of anyone else.
- 3. You must not post or distribute messages, videos or photos without permission from the other person.
- 4. The rules of manners and behaviors also apply on social media.
- 5. Bullying is not allowed at school, including on social media.
- 6. Do not post messages, videos or photos that are threatening, discriminatory, damaging or hateful to a pupil, teacher or the school.
- 7. You must not mention teachers' names in your posts.

It is important that you follow these rules. If you do not keep to these rules, the school will inform your parent(s) /guardian(s) and take measures. In serious situations this may even include expulsion from school.

# Mobile phones

- 1. Your mobile phone stays at home or goes into your locker. The use of your mobile phone is also not allowed during breaks.
- 2. It is never allowed to make image and/or sound recordings of teachers, other people working in the school or pupils.

### Break

During the break you go downstairs. You are not allowed to take break on the 1st or 2nd floor. During the break you stay on the school compound.

#### Intermission

When you have an interval, you go to the auditorium or outside. You are not allowed to be on the 1st or 2nd floor. During the intermission period you stay on the school compound.

# Code of conduct

During intake, the code of conduct will be discussed with the new pupil and their parent(s), carer(s) or guardian(s). The code of conduct will then be presented to the pupil and signed by the pupil.

At the beginning of each school year, the mentors will discuss the contents of the code of conduct in detail with the mentees. During the school year, the code of conduct recurs regularly in the mentoring lessons, so that pupils are permanently aware of the rules and expectations within the school.

In addition, pupils sign the code of conduct together with their mentor every school year. This keeps the agreements up to date and emphasizes the importance of a respectful and safe learning environment.
